S. R. O. 76 (I)/2015.—In exercising powers conferred by Section 6 of the Pakistan Coinage Act, 1906 (III of 1906), the Federal Government is pleased to authorize State Bank of Pakistan to issue Rs. 20 Commemorative Coin with effect from 31st January 2015 in quantity of 50,000 (fifty thousand) pieces on the occasion of “TO Mark Pakistan-China Year of Friendly Exchanges 2015” and for that purpose make the following determination of dimension, design and composition of the coin namely:—

Rs. 20	Cupro-Nickel (75% Copper & 25% Nickel)	<p>The coin will be round with serration on the edge and a diameter of 27.5 mm weighing 10 Grams.</p> <p>OBVERSE: The waxing crescent moon and a five pointed star facing north-west in rising position is in the centre on the obverse face of the coin. Alongwith periphery on the top of the crescent star is inscribed in wording "ISLAMI JAMHURIA PAKISTAN" in Urdu script. Below the crescent and at the top of two springs of wheat with arms curved upward, there is the year of issuance 2015. The face value of the coin in numeral "20" in bold letters and RUPIA in Urdu script are written on the right and left sides of crescent star respectively.</p> <p>REVERSE: There are national flags of Islamic Republic of Pakistan and People Republic of China in the center of reverse side of the coin. Pakistani flag is shown at right side of the coin whereas Chinese flag at the left side. The wording "YEAR OF FRIENDLY EXCHANGE 2015" is inscribed above these two flags and alongwith the periphery of the coin.</p>
