Subject: - **2024 MULTILATERAL TRAINING PROGRAMS UNDER CHINA AID**

The Economic Affairs Division vide its O.M No.2(1)EA/China-II/2024 dated 19th April, 2024 states that Government of People's Republic of China has offered various Multilateral Training Courses / Seminars in different disciplines for the month of May to June, 2024 for officers of Government of Pakistan (**List Attached**). Chinese side further informed that candidates cannot be withdrawn once nominated and the final application result will be subject to the MOFCOM. The Government of Pakistan will not be liable to bear any cost. The requisite general requirements are as under:-

Eligibility Criteria:

- Officers (**BPS-17 & above**).
- Most relevant to the training programmes.
- Proficiency in English.
- **Maximum age limit is 50 years for BS-20 & above, and 45 years for BS-17-19.**
- **Contract Employees are not eligible.**


Documents Required

The following documents (**02 sets of each**) are required to be sent alongwith the nomination:

- Application Form
- Information Form duly filled in by the nominee.
- FTC Proforma.
- Copy of CNIC.
- Copy of Passport at least six months of remaining validity and blank visa pages.
- Medical Certificate (Foreigner Physical Examination Form)
- Surety Bond
- Undertaking
- No criminal record certificate or Police Clearance Certificate attested by Ministry Foreign Affairs of Pakistan, if not visited China with 5 years.

2. Officers of Finance Division, who fulfill the given eligibility criteria, are requested to furnish their nominations duly recommended by the AFS/head of the Wing concerned alongwith required documents to **QA-I Section** before submission dates mentioned against each training. For further details/ information/ forms / FTC Proforma are available at **EAD's website: www.ead.gov.pk**.

Note:- "In addition to the eligibility criteria specified for a training, all officers who are working on contract basis/fixed pay package or having less than two years continuous government service or less than three months of service in Finance Division or against whom disciplinary proceedings/inquiry is in progress, may need not apply".
