Eligibility Criteria:-

KOICA Master's Degrees

- Be Government employees (BS 17) and above.
- Preferably Under the age of 40
- Citizen of a partner country, officially recommended by the country's government.
- Holder of Bachelor's degree from a recognized institution.
- Must meet the university's selection criteria.

KOICA Doctoral Degrees

- Those meeting the above selection criteria for a Master's degree
- A Master's degree holder of KOICA's Scholarship Programs
- Applicants who have passed the local interview for the "2025-1 KOICA Scholarship Program" are not eligible to apply for the "2025-2 KOICA Scholarship Program".
