Subject:- **E-LEARNING COURSE ON “CERTIFICATE IN COOPERATIVE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT THROUGH MICROFIANCE” TO BE HELD FROM 28<sup>TH</sup> JUNE 2021 TO 2<sup>ND</sup> JULY, 2021 UNDER THE MALAYSIAN TECHNICAL COOPERATION PROGRAMME (MTCP).**

**Eligibility Criteria:**

- Nominated by respective government from ASEAN and ASIA PACIFIC countries.
- Cooperative leaders with minimum of three years experience as a board or manager of cooperatives.
- Government officers with minimum of three years working experience supervising cooperative movement in their respective countries.
- 26-50 years of age.
- Has never participated in any MTCP courses.
- Proficient in English language, and medically fit.

**Objectives:**

- Participants will gain knowledge on how microfinance can helps in addressing pressing social issues and built resilient communities. This course provides understanding on fundamentals of microfinance in cooperative, its products services, issues, challenges and strategies as tools for community development.
- Participants will able to hare experience among each other on how to improve the socio-economic status of cooperative members and communities in their respective countries.

**Note:-** “In addition to the eligibility criteria specified for a training, all Officers who are working on contract basis/fixed pay package or having less than three months of service in Finance Division or against whom disciplinary proceedings / inquiry is in progress, may need not to apply”.
