Objective:


This course will share Singapore's experience in public policy and service delivery innovation, as well as the capabilities the public service needs to stay relevant.

Interested officers of Finance Division, who fulfill the given eligibility criteria, are requested to furnish their nominations duly recommended by the AFS/head of the wing concerned alongwith FTC Proforma & C.V to QA-I Section by **09.03.2026**. After approval from FTC the nominee will apply online at <https://go.gov.sg/fy26-port> as required by Singapore (Mandatory). Moreover, all officers proceeding on foreign trainings have been directed to submit a 1000-word post-visit report upon return to this Division and EAD.

Note:- "In addition to the eligibility criteria specified for a training, all officers who are working on contract basis/fixed pay package or having less than two years continuous government service or less than three months of service in Finance Division or against whom disciplinary proceedings/inquiry is in progress, may need not apply".
