This course will address environmentally sustainable development with focus on circular economy and the importance of promoting integrated solid waste management strategies for creating environmentally sustainable local and regional solutions in the context of policy, planning, practice, and innovation to advance a circular and sustainable materials management approach to optimize resource efficiency, recovery and reuse for socio-economic and ecological benefits.



Note:- *"In addition to the eligibility criteria specified for a training, all officers who are working on contract basis/fixed pay package or having less than two years continuous government service or less than three months of service in Finance Division or against whom disciplinary proceedings/inquiry is in progress, may need not apply".*
