Subject: **OFFLINE INTERNATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAMME ON
“CLIMATE RESILIENT TECHNOLOGIES FOR SUSTAINABLE
AQUACULTURE PRODUCTION IN DEVELOPING
COUNTRIES”. UNIVERSITY OF ZAMBIA (UNZA), ZAMBIA,
19-25 JUNE, 2023**

Akhtar Hameed Khan National Centre for Rural Development, (AHKNCRD), an Executive Department of the Establishment Division, Islamabad vide letter No. 1(4)/2015-16/II, Trg dated 22nd May, 2023 has informed that African Asian Rural Development Organization (AARDO) New Delhi, India is organizing subject international training programme in collaboration with the University of Zambia (UNZA), Zambia, from June 19-25, 2023. AARDO has invited two nominations from Pakistan to attend the subject training programme.

Entitlements:-

- Both ways international airfare from the capital city (Islamabad) to Lusaka, Zambia and back on an economy class by the shortest possible route;
- Boarding and lodging expenses at the Training Centre (excluding expenses on laundry, phone calls etc.);
- Tuition fee, books and literature;
- Expenses on local travel on study tours.

Objectives:-


- Identification of challenges associated with traditional systems of aquaculture with regard to climate change;
- Integrated aquaculture alternatives as models for climate resilient aquaculture for developing countries.
- Importance of climate resilient hatcheries for developing countries.

Eligibility Criteria:-

- Have Bachelor's Degree with an experience in the related fields.
- Have proficiency in spoken and written English language as the medium of conducting the programmes will be English only;
- Be in good health both physically and mentally to undergo the course of training;
- Be preferably below 45 years of age.

2. All interested Officers (BPS-17 & above) who fulfill the eligibility criteria are required to forward their nomination alongwith FTC Proforma, copy of CNIC & CV duly recommended by the Head of respective Wing to **QA-I Section latest by 31.5.2023**. After approval from FTC the applicant will submit online application at AARDO's website (<https://aardo.org/aardot.php>).

Note:- "In addition to the eligibility criteria specified for a training, all officers who are working on contract basis/fixed pay package or having less than two years continuous government service or less than three months of service in Finance Division or against whom disciplinary proceedings/inquiry is in progress or on probation period, may need not to apply"
